Treatment Program

The treatment team, led by a psychiatrist, focuses on assisting patients to obtain, as quickly as possible, an optimal level of functioning through the use of intensive therapy and medication management. At a minimum, patients have weekly individual and family therapy. Additionally, each patient participates in at least three clinical groups each day that focus on increasing coping skills to such an extent that the need for re-hospitalization will be greatly reduced. Additional daily activities include recreational therapy, addictions recovery group and a community meeting.

Continuity of care is a high priority. Patients are assisted to ensure that they have appointments for step down services specific to their continued needs. Step down services may include participation in a Day Treatment or Intensive Outpatient Program, securing an appointment with an individual therapist or psychiatrist in their community or identifying appropriate support groups. Upon discharge, clinical information will be forwarded to providers to whom the patient will return for continued treatment.

Admission Criteria

The Hiniker Unit may be appropriate for an individual who is:

- Age 18 or older
- Able to appropriately participate both cognitively and behaviorally in each group
- Not assaultive or aggressive toward others
- Newly diagnosed or has had periods of long-term sustained recovery and
- Currently resides in a safe, secure and supportive residence
- Is seeking a return back to a level of functioning that allows a return to home, work or school and the community

Referrals and Admissions

Appointments for an initial assessment to determine whether a prospective patient is appropriate for admission to the Hiniker Unit are scheduled between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm, seven days a week. During the appointment, the prospective patient is assessed to determine his/her ability to participate both cognitively and behaviorally in the treatment program. Prospective patients who do not have an appointment, i.e., walk-ins, who are admitted after hours or via an emergency transfer from another facility, will be admitted to the General Adult Unit until an assessment for appropriateness for the Hiniker Unit is completed. Patients who meet criteria will be transferred to the Hiniker Unit during routine admission hours (9:00 am - 9:00 pm).
